Arrival of Heifers: May arrive after noon Monday, June 17 & must be in place by Thursday, June 20 at noon Judging Date: Friday, June 21, 2024 - 8:00 AM Release Time: Immediately following show, animals must least premises by Noon Saturday, June 22 Entry Fee: \$10 per animal, Late entries \$25 per animal. Class winners and showmanship winners will each receive a special award. ALL youth participants will be eligible to win prizes! Barn help will be available to assist in care of animals Wednesday during the day as well as evening chores on Wednesday (youth contest day) and Thursday (farm tour and evening activity). Bedding will be provided.

GENERAL RULES

Eligibility: Must be a National Ayrshire Junior Member, applications and payment can be made at the show. Exhibitors may participate the year of their 9th birthday and until December 31 of the year in which he or she turns 21 years old. There will be a peewee showmanship class for younger kids. **Ownership:** Animals may be owned solely by the junior exhibitor or in a partnership provided the junior exhibitor's name appears on the registration papers. Registration papers will be checked at the show. In lieu of ownership, a lease agreement will be accepted. An approved lease of a 4-H, state or FFA program will be recognized upon verification at the National Ayrshire Office. If a lease program is not available in your state, a form may be obtained from the National office.

Participation:

a. Only one animal may be exhibited by each exhibitor in each class. Not more than four may be shown in the entire show that were not bred by the exhibitor. In order to qualify as breeder, the registration papers must show the Junior exhibitor or a partnership including the junior exhibitor as the breeder.

b. One substitution out of class will be permitted, as well as one substitution within class.

c. To be eligible to compete for the cash awards, ribbons or recognition, an animal must be shown by the Junior in all cases except by prior written approval. If approved, another Junior must show the animal. Adults are not allowed to show in any case.

d. White pants must be worn. A National Ayrshire Youth Heifer Show t-shirt will be provided to all exhibitors.

Entry Fee: Exhibitors mailing entries postmarked on or before June 1 must pay a fee of \$10.00 per head. Entries to be mailed to: Show Secretary, Rebekah Headings, 1335 Lombard Chuckery Rd., Plain City, OH 43064.

All animals exhibiting in a national Ayrshire show must be verified as at least 87% Ayrshire by the U.S. Ayrshire Breeders Association.
